Thanks were also expressed to Noel-Ann Bradshaw for her commitment to maths support over many years, as a **sigma** regional Hub Co-ordinator and more recently as a co-opted member to the Steering Group representing the IMA. Noel-Ann stood down from the Steering Group earlier in the year, but has been replaced by Michael Grove.

In addition, a new co-opted position was introduced on the Steering Group of Membership Officer based at the University of Bath (who are to host our new membership database in line with GDPR requirements), and Ed Southwood was welcomed to this role.

#### 5) Plans for the sigma Network in the coming year

The meeting was asked for suggestions from those in attendance that could feed into the activities of the **sigma** Network in the coming year. The Chair pointed out that last year, six specific suggestions were received and five successfully implemented.
